FIRE OFFICER ONE CERTIFICATION

Documentation of training is to be submitted with the required **Application for Fire Officer I Certification Examination (DFS-K4-1447)**, **Personal Inquiry Waiver (DFS-K4-1020)**, along with all other supporting documents and processing fee, at least 10 business days prior to the scheduled test date.

Download **Fire Officer I Application** for all necessary forms.

Seven 40-hour courses and three 16-hour courses (or equivalent) are required for certification. The courses are offered at the Florida State Fire College, Community and Junior Colleges throughout the state, and some of the Certified Training Centers.

3. FFP 2811 Firefighting Tactics II
4. FFP 1740 Fire Service Course Delivery

Plus the following 16-hr courses (or equivalent)

1. I-200 Basic Incident Management

FIRE OFFICER II CERTIFICATION

To receive the Fire Officer II Certificate of Competency, the applicant **must hold a Fire Officer I Certificate of Competency**, Possess Fire Officer I Certification and successfully complete 320 hours of basic certification training for Fire Officer II, or have received equivalent training in another state.

Documentation of training is to be submitted with the required **Application for Fire Officer II Certification (DFS-K4-1448)**, **Personal Inquiry Waiver (DFS-K4-1020)**, along with all other supporting documents and processing fee.

Download **Fire Officer II Application** for all necessary forms.

Eight 40-hour courses are required for certification. The courses are offered at the Florida State Fire College, Community and Junior Colleges throughout the state, and some of the **Certified Training Centers**.
